# Rewards and incentives

- Stimulate open publishing with a factor in the **Norwegian Publication Indicator**
- Require institutions to deposit in **local or national repositories** in order for articles to count in performance-based funding system

# Technical stuff

- Create **national** academic repository
- Strengthening register of approved publication channels
- *Norwegian Centre for Research Data or other gatekeepers against predatory journals?*
- *Alignment/coordination?*
- *What about DOAJ?*

# Fostering a culture of academic responsibility

- Academic **freedom** is essential
