

UK Research Reserve -

The journey of de-duplication continues

UK Research Reserve (UKRR) is a programme set up to alleviate space shortage problems. A strategic partnership between the Higher Education sector and the British Library, UKRR aims to help participating members dispose of duplicated holdings as well as retain scarce material for the UK research community. With funding support from HEFCE, UKRR works closely with the British Library and SUNCAT and has provided services to the library sector since 2007. So far, we have:

- ❖ De-duplicated more than **104km** of material (**12,940 m²**)
- ❖ Realised more than **£25m/€32m** capital savings; **£2.5m/€3.2m** pa estate costs
- ❖ Retained more than **18,000** scarce holdings
